All visitors to TCS must present passes to Brooklyn Navy Yard Security, at the Clinton Gate if driving, or before entering the elevator in the lobby of building 77. All visitors' names and email addresses must be provided to TCS before their visit, and your TCS contact will issue you Daily Visitor Passes (QR codes) directly.


AT BUILDING 77

Entering from Paulding St.:

• Turn right at the front desk that you will see on your right.

Entering from Flushing Ave.:

- Turn left past the front desk that you will see on your left.
- Use your provided QR code to pass the gate.
- Use the elevators for 9th floor of building 77 in the Brooklyn Navy Yard in suite 901.
- At suite 901, ring the doorbell on the left.



GETTING THERE

SUBWAY

The Brooklyn Navy Yard is conveniently reached by subway. Employees and registered visitors can use various subway lines (F, G, A, C, 2, 3, 4, 5, B, D, N, Q, R) to connect to nearby stations, where a free Yard shuttle is available.

FROM A-TRAIN: WALK

Exit A train at Jay Street-Metrotech. Walk on Jay Street toward Johnson Street, turn right on Tillary Street toward Flatbush Ave Ext, then left on Gold Street. Turn right on Nassau Street and proceed to Flushing Ave. Enter Building 77.

SHUTTLE

The Brooklyn Navy Yard provides a free weekday shuttle for employees and registered visitors between DUMBO (connects to A, C, F trains) and Atlantic Terminal (connects to G, 2, 3, 4, 5, B, D, N, Q, R, LIRR trains). Use the <u>Live Shuttle Tracker for real-time</u> updates.

BUS ROUTES

Take towards Maspeth Fresh Pond Rd, Jay/Willoughby Street. Get off at Flushing and Clermont Street.

B67

Take towards

VISITOR VEHICLE PERMITTING

Visitors needing to park in the Yard must have a Proxyclick Daily Visitor Parking Pass (QR code). The Daily Visitor Parking Pass is a printable permit that must be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle. Visitors must comply with all parking regulations.

DRIVE

For GPS navigation use "141 Flushing Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11205, Bldg. 77". For parking and loading dock/pickup deliveries, use "Clinton Ave Gate." All pickup returns should go to the loading dock near Freight 56. Call 212-247-6517, and ensure you have a copy of the order for Clinton Gate Security.

PARK

To access the parking lot, turn north on Clinton Ave from Flushing and use the TCS-provided parking permit sent via email. Three lots are within walking distance to Building 77: 275 Park Ave (closest), 504 Myrtle Ave, and 172 Vanderbilt Ave. Non-metered parking is available under the BQE along Park Avenue.

BIKE

There are three nearby Citibike docking stations: Flushing Ave & Vanderbilt Ave, Clinton Ave & Flushing Ave, and Washington Ave & Park Ave. There is a bike room on the 2nd floor of Building 77.

FERRY

The Brooklyn Navy Yard is accessible by NYC Ferry's Astoria Route, stopping at Dock 72. After disembarking, walk through the parking lot and enter Building 77. Refer to the <u>Astoria Route Ferry Schedule</u> for details.

EQUIPMENT DROP-OFF, PICK-UP, AND RETURN

Customers and drivers cannot take the TCS freight elevator for any reason. After handing off any carts or gear to a technician at the loading dock of freight 56 on the ground level, visitors with a valid pass can then enter the building to get to our space by coming into the main lobby of Building 77 and then taking the passenger elevators to the 9th floor and buzzing in at Suite 901. Production Vehicles, using the Clinton Gate entrance, should head to Freight 56 unless otherwise instructed. Email or print a copy of the order for your driver(s) for Navy Yard security clearance. Upon arrival, drivers and clients should call 212-582-3749, providing their name and production company. A receiving or prep technician will promptly assist with the equipment. Do not park and use the passenger elevator.
